

#### What is mobile?




### Mobile is a big deal

- Pew: As of Sept. 2012, 85% of U.S. adults own a cell phone.
- Comscore: As of Dec. 2013, 233 million U.S. cell phone users.
- That's 80% of all Americans over age 5.
- 54% of U.S. cell phones are smartphones
- Only 36% are iPhones; 54% are Android




#### Big jump in gadget ownership over the holidays


% of adults who own tablet computers and e-book readers

## Cell-mostly internet access

- 31% of all U.S. adults with an internet-connected cell phone say it's their PRIMARY way to access the net (or net-enabled content/services).
- 60% go online from their phone "sometimes"
- 45% age 18-29 are cell-mostly.
- 51% African-American, 42% Latino, 24% white
- 42% income >\$30,000/year
- 40% people who aren't college graduates
- 33% each urban, rural (28% suburban)



## Rich smartphone users don't play games, don't tweet

Reverse-engineering the smartphone habits of rich people might get us to being wealthy or it might not, but in either case the findings of a study show that rich people **tend not to play games, not to tweet**, but instead go and download news, travel or financial applications.

This is the conclusion The Luxury Institute arrived at after studying app usage among customers with income of \$150,000 or more a year. Coincidentally, those users tend to be older, with a mean age of 52.

"As you get older and have family and significant others, aging parents,

and a lot more assets and investments, you're going to need apps for far more relevant things than playing games and chatting with your peers," said Milton Pedraza, CEO of The Luxury Institute.







## Mobile-friendly e-mail

- 36% of all e-mail is read on a mobile device
- Use mobile-friendly e-mail templates
- No right column
- Few images (and keep them small)
- No big blocks of text
- Links should go to mobile-friendly destinations.










## Mapping

- Add geodata (addresses, lat/long data) to everything you can.
- Clickable links (addresses, etc.) open map apps on phones/tablets
- Crowdmaps are cool, but probably more useful for publishing than crowdsourcing




# Problems with building your own app:

- Software development project: \$\$\$
- Platform-specific, ongoing maintenance/updates
- Tools to generate apps = "shovelware"
- People must discover, download, remember to run: hurdles!
- 75% of apps never get opened more than 3x
- If community is small, less justification.
- More bang for buck from mobile web, etc.






# You might really need a native app if...

- You already have a great mobile-friendly website.
- You have a lot of money/time to spend or a skilled app developer on staff.
- Users need to store your content for offline use.
- Local access to carrier data networks or wifi is spotty or slow.
- Strong need for security, or hardware features.
   (GPS, accelerometer, etc.)


### Homework!
