







Wednesday November 21 2007, 01:38 PM Distribution of US Foreign Aid over time, 1946-2005












Fig. 8 — The type of graph used by Florence Nightingale in 1858 to which she gave the name Coxcomb.




Causes of Mortality in the Army in the East April, 1854 to March 1855




Regular people don't want data

- Dave Richard's projections.


To view projected or actual Fantasy points for a player in a given week, mouse over their circle for the particular week. Fantasy point data (projected and actual) are from AccuScore.


